CONDOLENCE ON THE DEATHS OF MESSES. ZAMID BUSSAIN AND HARI KISHORE PRASAD, BABU BRAJKISHORE PRASAD AND PANDIT MADAN MOHAN MALVIVA.

The Hon'ble the SPEAKER: It is now my painful duty to refer to the heavy loss that the province has sustained by the sad demise of two of our colleagues since we met last, namely, Mr. Zahid Hussian and Mr. Hari Kishore Prasad. Mr. Zahid Hussian was a member of the Sitamarhi Bar where he had a flourishing practice. He was elected a member of this Assembly on the Muslim League ticket last year from the Sitamarhi Muhammadan Rural Constituency. He died of heart failure in the afternoon of the 9th September last in the Sitamarhi Court. He was associated with various committees of rural uplift and social welfare and was a prominent member of his locality. His career was full of promise and his death is greatly to be deplored. DISTRIBUTION OF SEEDS TO CULTIVATORS.

- 158, Mr. RAM BASAWAN RAM: Vill the Hon ble Minister in charge of Agriculture be pleased to state—
- (v) whether Government propose to distribute Rabi seeds to the cultivators-
 - (i) free of cost,
 - (ii) at concession rates,
 - (ii) at market rates;
- (b) if the answer to clause (a) be in the affirmative, the time when Government will begin to distribute the seeds in each case;
 - (c) the names of the seeds Government propose to distribute?

The Hon'ble Dr. SAIYID MAHMUD: (a) Government propose to distribute wheat seeds to cultivators in the next Rabi season.

- (i) No.
- (ii) and (iii) Under the Grow More Food Campaign the cultivators are eligible to 20 per cent rebate, which is calculated on the cost price to the department. The whole question as regards future policy is under examination by Government.
 - (b) In October.
 - (c) Mainly wheat. Small quantities of gram will also be distributed.

HARASSMENT OF VETERINARY ASSISTANTS BY THE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF CIVIL VETERINARY DEPARTMENT, CENTRAL RANGE, PATMA.

- (a) whether it is a fact that many Veterinary Assistant Surgeons of the Central Range are so much oppressed by the present Assistant Director that they are seeking transfer, leave or resignation;
- (b) if it is a fact that there is a dearth of hands in the Veterinary Department;
- (c) if it is a fact that one Assistant Veterinary Surgeon has submitted his resignation due to the aforesaid oppression?
