QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS.

RECOGNISED SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN BIHAR AND ORISSA.

- 131. Rai Bahadur LACHHMI PRASHAD SINHA: Will Government be pleased to state—
- (a) the number of recognised secondary schools in this province and the number of pupils at each of them,
 - (b) how many of them are managed by private bodies,
 - (c) how many of them receive grant-in-aid,
- (d) the income of each such school from fee and other sources and also the amount of Government grant they get?
- Mr. B. K. GOKHALE: On the 31st of March, 1932, there were in the province 918 secondary schools with 131, 569 pupils. Of these schools 38 were managed by Government, 325 by local bodies and 555 by private agencies: of the latter 450 were aided.

The other information required is not available and cannot be collected without an expenditure which will not be justified by the result.
