DUPLICATE BUS SERVICES ON ROADS IN THE DISTRICT OF PALAMAU.

382. Mr. JITU RAM* : Will Government be pleased to state—

(a) whether they have issued any instructions to the Deputy Commissioner of Palamau for the duplication of bus service in the district on all roads on which buses ply on hire;

(b) if the answer to clause (a) be in the affirmative, whether the Deputy Commissioner has given effect to the aforesaid orders;

(c) if the answer to clause (b) be in the negative, the reason for the same?

Mr. KRISHNA BALLABH SAHAY : (a) and (c) The answer is in the negative. The number of permits granted by a District Officer for running bus service on a particular road depends upon local conditions, viz., condition of the road, local demand, etc.

(b) if it is a fact that again on the 18th October, 1938 at 3 o'clock in the night, the said Karam Bir Singh referred to in clause (a) entered the house of Babu Tulsī Prasad of Hazaribagh as stated by him in a written report sent to Sadr thana praying to institute a case on said Karam Bir Singh under section 457 of the Indian Penal Code;
