SHORT NOTICE QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS.

RE-ORGANISATION OF THE DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION.

333. Shri AMBIKA SINGH : Will the Chief Minister be pleased to state—

(1) whether Government have formulated a scheme of re-organisation of the District administration, redefining the duties and powers of the District Officer and giving him control over officers of all the Departments working in the district ;

(2) if the answer to the aforesaid clause be in the affirmative the details of the scheme and the considerations necessitating the formulation of the scheme ?

Shri KRISHNA BALLABH SAHAY : (1) and (2) A copy of Appointment Department's Order no. 6828, dated the 16th September 1955 is laid on the Library table. All the information required is contained in it.

Shri AMBIKA SINGH : Is it a fact that this scheme was circulated to various Governmental Departments and they expressed their opinion against the acceptance of the scheme ?

Shri KRISHNA BALLABH SAHAY : All the Departments of Government were asked to submit their opinion but those opinions are confidential and so no reference can be made to them .

Shri AMBIKA SINGH : Is it a fact that this scheme is based on the recommendations of the Rowland Committee ?

Shri KRISHNA BALLABH SAHAY : I cannot answer this question.

Shri AMBIKA SINGH : Did Government take advantage of the recommendations contained in the Rowland Committee Report in draft in this scheme ?

Shri KRISHNA BALLABH SAHAY : There was no doubt that there is some reference in the scheme about the recommendations of that Committee, but I cannot say that the scheme is based on the findings of that Committee. The scheme has been prepared by the present Government and is original in character.

(5) whether it is a fact that the Magistrate under threat of arrest forcibly took something in writing from her relations which contained that the deceased had died due to a chronic disease ;

(6) if the answers to the above clauses be in the affirmative what steps have been taken by Government to punish such an officer ?

श्री कृष्ण बल्लभ सहाय—(१ से ५). इसकी जांच हो रही है ।

(६) जांच की रिपोर्ट आने के बाद सरकार इस पर कार्रवाई करेगी ।

श्री योगेश्वर घोष—कौन अधिकारी इस केस की जांच करेंगे ?

श्री कृष्ण बल्लभ सहाय—कमिश्नर जांच करेंगे ।

श्री त्रिवेणी कुमार—सरकार ने अभी बताया कि जांच अभी चल रही है तो मैं जानना चाहता हूँ कि क्या सरकार उस रिपोर्ट को सदन के सामने उपस्थित करेगी ?

श्री कृष्ण बल्लभ सहाय—ऐसा कोई मसाला सरकार की नहीं है । जांच के बाद जो

रिपोर्ट आयेगी उसके मुताबिक सरकार उचित कार्रवाई करेगी ।

श्री त्रिवेणी कुमार—अध्यक्ष महोदय, सरकार ने तो इस प्रश्न का उत्तर नहीं दिया,

अतः इसे एंड इंटरीम अंश में समझा जाये क्योंकि यह बहुत ही इम्पोर्टेंट प्रश्न है ।

श्री कृष्ण बल्लभ सहाय—अभी इसकी जांच हो रही है । जांच के बाद अगर

इस प्रश्न का उत्तर देने के लिये कहा जाये तो हमें कोई उच्च नहीं होगा ।

अध्यक्ष—इसे मैं एंड इंटरीम उत्तर मानता हूँ । सेशन के समय तक पूरा उत्तर

आ गया तो ठीक ही है नहीं तो दूसरे सत्र में फिर से प्रश्न पूछना पड़ेगा । फिर भी मैं इसे स्थगित करता हूँ ।

PARTS OF BIHAR TO WEST BENGAL.

326. Shri JAGANNATH SINGH : Will the Chief Minister be pleased to state—

(1) whether the attention of Government has been drawn to the news published in Calcutta English daily, dated 4th October, 1955 under the caption "West Bengal to get New Lands : How the Re-organised 16 States will stand" ;

(2) whether it is a fact that Bihar is going to lose part of Purnea and Sadar Subdivision of Manbhum minus one P.-S. to West Bengal and there is no indication of any addition to Bihar in return for this loss ;

(3) if the answers to clauses (1) and (2) be in the affirmative, what steps Government propose to take for rectifying the wrong done to the State by the States Reorganisation Commission and representing to the Union Government the true and overwhelming feelings of the Public in this regard?

Shri KRISHNA BALLABH SAHAY : (1) The answer is in the affirmative.

(2) The States Reorganisation Commission has recommended the transfer of a part of the Purnea district to the east of the river Mahananda extending to the south up to the National Highway 34 in the Karandighi Police Station, and the whole of the Sadar Subdivision of Manbhum minus Chas Revenue Thana to West Bengal. There is no recommendation for any addition of territory to Bihar.

(3) The State Government are conscious of the widespread feeling of resentment in the States Reorganisation Commission. They will, however, send their comments and views on the report of the Commission to the Government of India after consulting the State Legislature. It is hoped the Parliament will take into consideration the views of the State Government and the State Legislature before taking a decision on the report of the Commission.

डा० श्रीकृष्ण सिंह—करीब एक हफ्ता हुआ ।

Shri JAGANNATH SINGH : Are Government aware of the fact that the substance of the report of the S. R. C. has appeared in the press of Bengal which substantially appears to be true ?

Shri KRISHNA BALLABH SAHAY : Many publications have since appeared in the press and it will facilitate if any concrete publication is made mention of and then only I would be in a position to answer this question.

श्री जगन्नाथ सिंह—हमने प्रश्न के साथ प्रेस की कटिंग दी थी जिसमें कहा गया है

Shri JAGANNATH SINGH : I would like to know whether the Bihar Cabinet has considered the recommendation of the S. R. C. ?

Shri KRISHNA BALLABH SAHAY : Not yet.

Shri JAGANNATH SINGH : Sir, I would like to know if the Bihar Cabinet is going to consider the Commission's report in the context of the agitation and repercussion of the people throughout the length and breadth of the State ?

Shri KRISHNA BALLABH SAHAY : The Government will certainly do.

Shri JAGANNATH SINGH : I would like to know whether the reports of the Commission are based on grounds which are untenable and in utter disregard of the public opinion of the State ?

SPEAKER : The question does not arise.

Shri JAGANNATH SINGH : Sir, I would like to know whether Government are aware of the fact that the corridor idea is repugnant to the question of national solidarity ?

SPEAKER : The question does not arise.

Shri JAGANNATH SINGH : Sir, I would like to know what steps Government propose to take so that we might not lose any portion of our territory ?

Shri RAMCHARITRA SINHA : The hon'ble member should know that as the question has not yet been considered by the Cabinet, this question of taking step does not arise.

Shri TRIBENI KUMAR : How long will the Cabinet take to consider the report of the States Reorganisation Commission ?

Shri RAMCHARITRA SINHA : Cabinet will take immediate action to consider the report.

BAN ON FOREIGN FILMS.

341. Shri BAIJNATH SINGH : Will the Chief Minister be pleased to state—

(1) whether it is a fact that some foreign films about Africa are shown in Bihar ;

(2) whether it is a fact that such films are malicious and deliberately misrepresent the African people ;

(3) whether the Bihar Government will accept the spirit of Bandaung Conference and stop exhibition of such films in the State ?

Shri KRISHNA BALLABH SAHAY : (1), (2) and (3). It is not possible to say anything definite about the contents of a film unless its name is specified. It may be pointed out, however, that no foreign (or Indian) film—about Africa or any thing else—can be exhibited in Bihar or any State unless it is certified by the Central Board of Film Censors. This Board on doubt, keep in mind the principles of international peace and co-existence that India follows, and the Ban aung Conference reaffirmed. It is, therefore, unlikely that they would certify for exhibition in India any film which, in part or in whole, violates those principles.
