SHORT NOTICE QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS.

IMMEDIATE RECOURSE TO COMPULSORY RETIREMENT OF THE DIRECTOR OF VETERINARY SERVICES.

- *56. Mr. BIRENDRA BAHADUR SINHA: Will the Hon'ble the Minister Incharge of the Development Department be pleased to state—
- (a) whether it is a fact that as a result of an enquiry conducted against the Director of Veterinary Services on various grave charges. Government asked the said officer to take immediate recourse to compulsory retirement;
- (b) if the answer to clause (a) be in the affirmative, the reason responsible for causing so much of delay in the execution of the said order?
- Mr. BIR CHANDRA PATEL: The answer to this question cannot be given in public interest.
- Mr. JADUBANS SAHAY: May I know why this question was assented to by the Hon'ble Minister Incharge?
- Mr. BIR; CHANDRA PATEL: Government had admitted this question; but after examination of the matters involved, Government have come to this decision.
- Mr. PURUSHOTTAM CHOHAN: Did the Hon ble Minister examine the question?
- Mr. BIR CHANDRA PATEL': The Hon'ble Minister In charge of the Department tried his best to accommodate the members but when all the facts came to his knowledge Government came to this decision that in public interest it would not be proper to give an answer to this question.
