## UNSTARRED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS.

COMPLAINT OF INCIVILITY AGAINST THE NURSES OF THE PATNA MEDICAL COLLEGE HOSPITAL.

**113. Mr. SUKHLAL SINGH :** Will Government be pleased to state—

(a) whether it is a fact that the nurses and especially the Anglo-Indian nurses attached to the Patna Medical College Hospital call the patients in general by using the word "tum" and not "ap" ;

(b) if the answer to clause (a) be in the affirmative, what action, if any, Government propose to take in the matter ?

**Mr. BINODANAND JHA :** (a) Government are informed that this is not so.

(b) The question does not arise.

**Mr. SUKHLAL SINGH :** What is the basis of the information ?

**Mr. BINODANAND JHA :** Report from the Superintendent of the Medical College Hospital.

**Mr. HARIKISHORE PRASHAD :** Did the Superintendent enquire from the patients ?

**Mr. BINODANAND JHA :** Government believe that such reports are given after enquiry.
