UNSTARRED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS.

PETITION FROM TENANTS OF VILLAGES SITUATED ON THE NORTH SIDE OF RIVER SIKRAHNA FOR REMISSION OF RENT.

108. Mr. BAIDYANATH MISRA: Will Government be pleased to state—

(a) whether it is a fact that the tenants of the villages situated on the north side of the river Sikrahn in the police-stations Sugauli and Motihari, filed petitions before the Collector of Champaran and the Manager of the Bettiah Raj under Court of Wards for the remission of rent for last year and the previous years;

(b) if the answer to clause (a) be in affirmative, whether the remission of rent has been granted to the tenants; if not, why not;

(c) whether they propose to make a thorough enquiry into the situation and grant an adequate remission in rent to the tenants of the area in question?

Mr. KRISHNA BALLABH SAHAY: (a), (b) and (c) Information is being collected and will be made available to the hon'ble member when obtained.
