MR. BREMNER: (a) The liability of parts of the Bhabhua subdivision

to famine has been recognized for many years.

In 1914 the Government of the United Provinces offered a supply of water from an irrigation project to be constructed by the Maharaja of Benares. The details of the scheme have been worked out for a supply of water to 41,000 acres of rice. The project was, however, postponed indefinitely by the United Provinces Government for financial reasons.

The question of irrigation from the *Durgaoti* and other smaller rivers has been considered, but the supply of water in these rivers is so precarious that it was decided the that it was decided they could not be relied on at times of drought.

(b) Government propose to await further action of the United Frovinces Government regarding the Karamnasa scheme. With regard to the Durgaott and smaller streams, the water is used when required by the local zamindars who make bandhs as required.

A proposal for the extension of the Main Western Canal is under consideration, but its success depends on the possibility of increasing the supply available from the Son.

Instructions excise officers in regard to temperance
