UNSTARRED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS.

ROAD CONNECTING BIHAB SHARIFF WITH BAJGIR DIRECT AND VIA NALANDA.

- 154. Mr. H. B. CHANDRA": Will Government be pleased to
- (a) whether it is a fact that portions of the road connecting Biharshariff with Rajgir direct and also via Nalanda are katcha and kept in ill repair
- (b) whether it is a fact that this is a busy road and that Rajgir is an important centre of attraction for outside visitors including international tourists;
- (c) whether they propose to effect any improvement in the condition of this road; if so, what, and within what time?

Pandit BINOBANAND JHA: (a) and (b) The answer is in the affirmative.

(c) The Patna district board has been spending Rs. 5,000 anually for metalling of the katchi portion of the road, but no provision could be made in 1938 39 for want of funds.

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In absence of the questioner, the answer was given at the request of Mr. Upendrameth Mukharji.

Mr. UPENDRANATH MUKHARJI: Is it a fact that the district board of Patna has applied to Government for a loan to metal this road along with other works?

Mr. BINODANAND JHA: The district board has applied for loan, but whether this loan is intended for metalling this road or other road can't be said without a notice.

Mr. UPENDRANATH MUKHARJI: Will Government consider the iden of giving some money from the road fund specially earmarked for this purpose?

Mr. BINODANAND JHA: The road belongs to the district board and the responsibility for its improvement rests with the district board; but in view of the importance of this road, Government are addressing the district board for improving this road as well as the sanitary conditions of Raigir.

Mr. UPENDRANATH MUKHARJI: How Government say that they will improve the road when there is no money allotted for it?

Mr. BINODANAND JHA: These things will be settled in negotiations which are to follow between the district board and Government.

Mr. RAM PRASAD: What portion of money the district board spends on the Bihar-Rajgir road?

Mr. BINODANAND JHA: I nek for notice.

Mr. JAMUNA PRASHAD SINHA: Is it a fact that some seven or eight years ago the Government of Bihar addressed the district boards of Gaya and Patha saying that if Rajgir was connected with the district town, the Government of Bihar would grant some money for the construction of the said road?

Mr. BINODANANO JHA : I ask for notice.

Mr. ABDUL MAJEED: Are Government aware that there is a road which connects Rajgir with the district of Gaya via Hasua?

Mr. BINODANAND JHA: The answer is in the affirmative
