- (b) 1,412. There is no fixed proportion for Bihar and Orissa but all the inmates of the Patna mental hospital, which is the only such institution in the province, will be transferred to the Indian mental hospital at Ranchi.
- (c) The management and organization of the hospital will for the present rest in the local Government, which will also make all appointments in consultation with the Government of Bengal.
