- (c) Re. 1-2-0 subject to a monthly maximum of Rs. 27 and an annual maximum of Rs. 275.
  - (d) Every Muhammadan sub-inspector of schools visits Maktabs in his circle as a matter of course. In districts containing no inspecting Maulavi the Hindu sub-inspectors of schools visit Maktabs merely to ascertain that they are working regularly, that the teacher and students are present, and so on. The real inspection is made by the special inspecting officer for Muhammadan education.
