DESIRABILITY OF ISSUING ORDERS FOR THE DRAWAL OF FOURTH INCRE-MENT IN THE PRESCRIBED SCALE OF PAY.

- \*26. Shrl MAHABIR PRASAD: Will the Hon'ble the Finance Minister be pleased to state—
- (a) whether it is a fact that many Government servants have not been able to draw their fourth increment in their pay due to their Pay Fixation statement not having been checked by the Accountant-General Bihar, so far;
- (b) if the answer to clause (a) be in the affirmative, whether Government propose to consider the desirability of issuing orders for the drawal of the fourth increment without the Pay Fixation Statement being checked, as in the case of previous increments.
- (c) if the answer to clause (b) be in the negative, the reasons for not doing so?

माननीय पं० विनोदानम्य साः (क्) एत्तर स्थीकारात्मक है।

- (स) उत्तर स्वीकारात्मक है, पर घोष्टं अर्थाभाव तथा चोरवाजारी को ब्रोत्साह<sup>म</sup> महीं देने के लिए भी इतने अधिक दर पर काम नहीं करा सकती है।

DESIFABILITY OF PRESCRIBING RATES FOR PREUMATIC TYRED CARTS.

\*42. Shri JHULAN SINHA: Will the Hon'ble Minister for the

Local Self-Government Department be pleased to state-

(a) whether it is a fact that as in the revised schedule of ferry boat rates of fare in Champaran district as approved by district board in its resolution no.12, dated the 20th December 1950 and by the Commissioner Tirhut Division, in his letter no. J.-557, dated the 17th February 1948 there is no mention of rates for pneumatic tyred carts drawn by a pair of bullock, the lessees concerned realise any amount which they like from the public;

(b) if the answer to clause (a) be in the affirmative, whether Government consider the desirability of instructing the said district board in particular and other boards in general to prescribe an uniform rate for such carts so that the public concerned may be spared the explication?

The Hon'ble Pandit BINODANAND JHA: (a) Answer is in the affirmative. (b) Rates of ferry tolls for those conveyances, including pneumatic tyred carts, which are not mentioned in the prescribed schedule or tolls, are under prepration by the Champaran District Board and other district boards are being instructed to act accordingly.

MISBEHAVIOUR OF DR. MAHAJAN OF RANCHI SADE HOSPITAL.

\*44. Shri PURNA CHANDRA MITRA: Will the Hon'ble Minister, Local Self-Government Department, be pleased to state—

(a) whether it is a fact that a poor man named Shri Kali Ram of Tharpakhana in the Ranchi town had been admitted in Ranchi Sadr Hospital as an indoor patient on the 2nd September 1950;

- (b) whether the said Kali Ram was examined by Dr. Jaffray in out-door first and admitted by him as indoor patient for pleuriasy with effusion and recommended for X'ray of his chest;
- (c) whether it is a fact that the Deputy Superintendent of the Hose pital Dr. Mahajan told Kali Ram's brother who came to see him on the 4th September 1950 that Kali Ram had been examined by him and he was found to be suffering from Asthma;

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(d) whether it is a fact that Kalir Ram's brother was insulted and turned out from the Hospital premises by Dr. Mahajan being annoyed with him when he said to him that Kali Ram had been examined and diagnosed by Dr. S. K. Basu as a case of pleuriasy with effusion prior to his taking admission in the Hospital;

(e) whether it is a fact that Dr. Mahajan in an angry mood asked

Kali Ram's brother to deposit Rs. 15 as X'ray fee?

The Hon'ble Pandit BINODANAND JHA: (a), (b) and (c) The answer is the affirmative.

- (d) and (e) Shri Kali Ram's brother Shri Jogeshwar Ram, a Sanitary Inspector of Ranchi District Board saw Dr Mahajan on 4th September 1950 in his office and requested him to have an X'ray of chest of his But as Dr Mahajan had examined Shri KaliRam on 3rd September 1950 and diagnosed his case to be Asthma, he did not think it necessary to X'ray his chest. On Shri Jogeshwar Ram's insistence, as Dr. S. K. Basu, a private practitioner had diagnosed the case as pleuriasy. Dr. Mahajan asked him to go out of his room and also said that if he wanted an X'ray done against his advice he would have to deposit Rs. 15 as X'ray fee.
- \*45. Shri PURNA CHANDRA MITRA: Will the Hon'ble Minister, Local Self-Government Department, be pleased to state—

(a) whether Kali Ram mentioned in starred questioned no. 44 was discharged from the Hospital on 8th September 1950 as was unable to pay the amount demanded by Dr. Mahajan;

(b) whether it is a fact that after Kali Ram had been discharged from the Hospital, he went to Dr. S. K. Basu who took out 20 c.o. of fluid from his chest on the 9th September last and on his request Dr. Paul took out

650 c.c. of fluid from his chest on the 10th September 1950:

(c) if the answer to clauses (a) and (b) be in affirmative, the action Government propose to take against Dr. Mahajan who under false pretext discharged a poor patient from the Hospital who was really suffering from a serious disease which has taken a bad turn now and to stamp out such corrupt practice amongst Hospital doctors employed in hospitals of the State Government?

The Hon'ble Pandit BINODANAND JHA: (a) Shri Kali Ram was discharged from Hospital on the 8th September 1950 on the advice of Dr. Mahajan and he left the Hospital of his own wish with a prescription from Dr. Mahajan. It is not a fact that he was discharged for not paying

(b) Government can only say that this is how the report goes.

(c) Dr. Mahajan had been concentrating since graduation only in surgery. As such he may have made a genuine mistake in diagnosing a medical case. The Civil Surgeon met Shri Kali Ram and he is now completely restored to health. The matter has been personally enquired into by the Inspector-General of Civil Hospitals and Dr. Mahajan has since been transfered from Ranchi and other appropriate action has been taken

Shri PURSHOTTAM CHOWHAN: What appropriate action has been taken against the said doctor?
