State institution and used directly for its benefit, a local committee or a board of trustees is constituted in respect of such funds. It may be stated that out of 23 State institutions referred to in (a) above, three only are special dispensaries for particular classes of Government servants, and 20 are open to the general public, so that any reference to State dispensaries in rural areas applies really to these 20 institutions of which seven are in the district of Angul alone where there are no local bodies.

Mr. W. H. LEWIS: (a) A European lady governess has been employed since 1922. In 1924 a *pandit* was engaged to teach the boys Sanskrit and Hindi who has since resigned. In 1925 a tutor, Rai Sahib Sangam Lal, was appointed on the recommendation of the grandfather of the wards.

(c) It is proposed to educate the wards at the Raipur College.

(d) No proposal to this effect has been made.
