The Hon'ble the President

as Chairman of the Saran district board he spent a large of amount of money for the fair, and practically removed the great difficulties of the fair, namely, dust and cholera. During the last three or four years not a single case of cholera has occurred in that fair, whereas every year before that a large number of people used to die of that disease.

He devoted himself almost night and day during the time the fair was held to the service of the people. I think it is very difficult, and almost impossible, to replace him at least in that district. I am sure that hon'ble members will permit me to convey on my behalf and on behalf of this Council a letter of condolence to his bereaved family.

I hope hon'ble members will kindly signify their assent by rising in their seats.
